



RULES & POLICIES FOR TRAINING CLASSES / WORKSHOPS

Jasper's Splash Zone will enforce the following rules to ensure safety and to mitigate risks for all our clients.

1. To ensure the safety of all client's companions visiting Jasper's Splash Zone, all dogs must be vaccinated or titered for rabies and DA2P-CPV (Distemper, Hepatitis, Parvovirus, Para influenza, Coronavirus). We also recommend the bordetella (kennel cough) vaccine.
2. Do not bring dogs that have health conditions that may endanger others.
3. Dogs in heat are NOT allowed on our property or in the facility.
4. You are responsible for your dog and its behavior while at Jasper's Splash Zone. You must attend to and manage your dog at all times. This includes your dog's interactions with other dogs and people. There is no lifeguard at the pool, so it is extremely important that you pay attention to your dog while at the facility. Dogs showing inappropriate aggression towards other dogs or people may be asked to take a time-out, or to leave the facility.
5. Dogs must always be leashed in all areas of the facility on a four (4) foot long or shorter leash except when it's appropriate to be off leash during training or a trial. NO retractable leashes are allowed on the premises. Additionally, you must keep your dog four (4) feet from any other dog that may be at the facility. This is important as dogs are often more excited at our facility, and may not behave, as you would normally expect them to.
6. You must allow your dog(s) the opportunity to use the bathroom outside in the designated potty areas before entering the field house training area, and every 10 to 20 minutes if your dog is here to swim. Bags and receptacles are provided. Incontinent dogs or dogs in heat are not permitted anywhere in our facility for health reasons. Please notify our staff if your dog has an accident ANYWHERE indoors (including the sports turf or on the dock/in the pool) so that it can be properly cleaned and sanitized. There is a **\$30** cleaning fee should your dog have any kind of accident on the sports turf area.
7. You are responsible for cleaning up after your dog outdoors. Please DO NOT let your dog go to the bathroom or mark on the outdoor sports fields, the dock, pool, pool sandbox, building and/or building posts . If we find that you did not clean up after your dog, or failed to inform

our staff of an accident ANYWHERE indoors, you will not be allowed back to our facility. Repeated accidents may also result in a ban for your dog.

8. If you are training with treats on the sports turf area, please be sure to pick up any treats that may have fallen.
9. Absolutely NO human food or drinks other than water is allowed in the field house training areas including the sports turf and pool areas.
10. No humans or dogs are allowed in the pool without explicit permission and no people or dogs are allowed on the dock if you are here for a training class, workshop, or event that does not involve the dock and/or pool.
11. Do NOT enter any gated area or the following areas without permission from our staff: The mezzanine, the utility, lodging, and pool equipment rooms. Additionally, people and dogs are NOT allowed on, or underneath the docks, nor on any of the immediate sides of the pool. Please remain on the sports turf and do not let your dog attempt to climb in the pool from the side of the pool.
12. Please note that the floors may be slippery, so please wear appropriate shoes. No bare feet, flip flops or slides allowed.
13. Children must be under parental control at all times. If you have children that are here to watch, there must be another adult with them that will supervise them.
14. Please check your class/workshop requirements if a crate is needed for you to bring to class. Many of our classes require you to crate your dog while other teams are handling their dog.
15. Above all, we want your time at our facility to be fun for you and your dog!
